INFORMATION NOTE

The consulate General of the Republic of Cameroon in Dubai, United Arab Emirates, informs Cameroonian nationals resident in United Arab Emirates that, in addition to the information contained in Information Note N°08/C/CGCD/PVC/21 of July 07, 2021, the following documents must be provide for the establishment/ renewal of ordinary passports at the Consulate General:

- the original birth certificate + certified true copy (to be certified at the Consulate General);
- the valid national identity card + certified true copy (to be certified at the Consulate General);
- the supporting document of the profession, if applicable;
- photocopy of the residence;
- the marriage certificate + certified true copy for the married woman (to be certified at the Consulate General);
- the photocopy of the previous passport for the renewal of passports;
- the photocopy of employment contract;
- parental authorization for minor children (to be certified at the Consulate General);
- the certified true copy of the valid passport/ NIC of the parent of a minor;
- 50AED representing the stamp fees for the certification of the different documents.

Users are reminded that their contribution for the routing of the passport by approved companies from Cameroon to Dubai is **200AED** per applicant.

The Consulate General therefore invites users to kindly, at the time of their enrollment, present all the documents listed above; failing will lead to the rejection by the new passport enrollment system.
